Parent Factor in ADHD Programme

This programme is specifically for parents, living in Cardiff, with children aged 7-16 with a clinical diagnosis of Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD).

The aims of this 8 week programme are to increase parents knowledge of ADHD and give parents insight into how it feels to be a child with ADHD. It also aims to give parents advice on how to foster a positive relationship with their child and to provide parents with strategies to support children to regulate their behaviour

The programme is fully funded by Cardiff Council so is offered at no cost to parents living in Cardiff. Each session is 2 hours long with refreshments provided and will be held in local community venues or schools across Cardiff.
